- 3. A \$1,000.00 scholarship to a Sarnia Sting player in good standing who is entering into full-time, first-year studies at any college or university in Ontario.

Each scholarship is a one-time grant. Scholarships are not solely based on past academic performance. Also considered will be the applicant's community involvement.
